The groom at Saltus, School, McGill, Montreal, Ontario, England recently called London.

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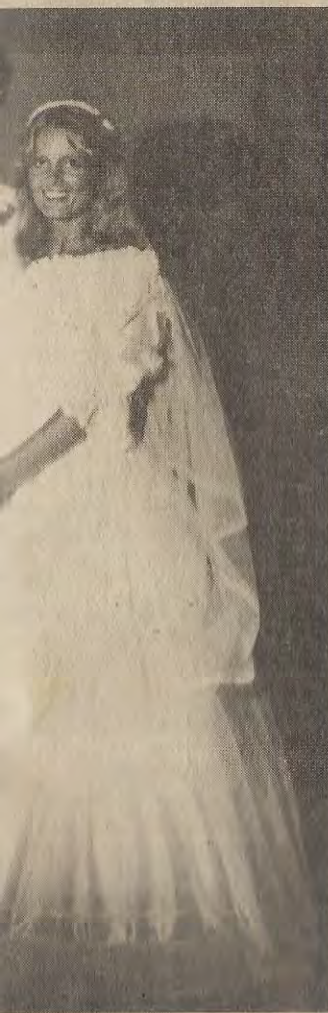


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The couple spent their
